


Behavior and Medical Neurology

Determination of a prognosis and development of a practical and effective treatment program is emphasized. In some cases, medication may be considered.

What to Expect:

During the initial visit, Dr. Hnilica will review the past treatments and tests to make sure we don't repeat tests or treatments unnecessarily.

Microscopic cytology will be performed to identify any secondary infection. The underlying disease causing the recurrent infections and symptoms will be identified.

Finally, an all-inclusive treatment plan for both immediate crisis and long-term control will be discussed.

Most patients, about 90%, have success within 2-3 visits and can be well controlled with a tremendous improvement in their skin disease.
